A "radical redesign" of children and young peoples' emotional health and wellbeing services.



Listen and respond to the voices of children, young people and their families.



Improve access and achieve better health and wellbeing outcomes.



Make sure health and care services in Sussex are co-designed by the people who use them.



Ensure investment in services and support, reflects the local need for mental health and wellbeing support.



Improve the accuracy and availability of health and care data to help plan and monitor the quality of services.



Ensure that health and care services are delivered in a more joined-up way.
