Face 2 Face provides emotional support for parents of children and young people with disabilities and additional needs. We particularly focus on supporting families in the early days, when a child is undergoing assessments or around the time of diagnosis.

How does Amaze Face 2 Face befriending work?

Face 2 Face is delivered by a team of volunteer befrienders, all parents of children with additional needs.

Do you feel you have the knowledge and experience to support other parents? We're looking to train up a team of volunteer befrienders in East Sussex. Training will run over June and July at the DC3 Workshop Space (1-5 Seaside, Eastbourne BN22 7NA) and includes listening skills, boundaries, safeguarding and the parent journey. It will run during school hours and expenses will be paid.
