Amaze is a charity that works with families of children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) in Sussex. By families, we mean parent carers *and* children and young people aged 0 to 25; our direct work with young people is from about 14.

Our definition of disability is very broad and you don't need to have a diagnosis to contact us. The range of services we offer varies across Sussex and some are specific to particular areas. See our website to check.

Amaze is an independent charity that works together with local services such as education, health and social care to get the best life possible for children and young people with additional needs.

Giving you a voice

We're committed to helping parents influence local services and policy-making. We participate in many consultation initiatives and support parents to take part.

Amaze works closely with local parent carer forums, PaCC, ESPCF and WSPCF to help influence local decision-making to get the best outcomes for disabled children and their families.

Amaze SENDIASS

Amaze SENDIASS is the Special Educational Needs and Disability Information, Advice and Support Service for **East Sussex** and **Brighton & Hove**. We offer impartial and confidential support with anything to do with special educational needs and disability (SEND) for 0-25 year olds.

We have online and printed resources so you can find things out for yourself, and a helpline for when you want individual advice or someone to steer you to the right information.

We also run regular workshops and courses where parent carers and young people can share experiences and learn more about useful topics.

The Compass and Compass Card

Amaze manages 'The Compass', a disability register of children and young people with significant additional needs aged 0 to 25 in **Brighton & Hove** and **West Sussex**. Compass data helps shape local services and all children on The Compass get a free Compass Card, which provides leisure discounts and offers across Sussex.

Face2Face befriending

Face2Face is a parent-to-parent befriending service offering families in **Brighton & Hove** and **East Sussex** one-to-one and group support around the time of diagnosis or other challenges.

Amazing Futures for young people

Amazing Futures is for young people aged 14-25 with learning disabilities or other kinds of disabilities in **Brighton & Hove** and **East Sussex**. Our free peer support groups and self advocacy group give young people a chance to make friends and talk about things that matter to them. We also have information for young people with disabilities on our website.

Looking Forward for young people

A chance for young people aged 14-25 with SEND in **Brighton & Hove** and **East Sussex** to prepare for their next steps in education, employment and training. Includes one-to-one sessions, group training and workshops.

Help with claiming DLA and PIP

Amaze can offer advice and sometimes practical support with making claims for Disability Living Allowance or Personal Independence Payment to families in **Brighton & Hove** and **East Sussex**.
