Foundations for our Future

Work continues on the Sussex-wide Foundations for our Future programme which seeks to drive improvement in **children and young people's mental health services**. It has identified 20 recommendations intended to drive forward muchneeded change, and Amaze and the three Sussex parent carer forums are involved in shaping how these recommendations are implemented. Young people from our Amazing Futures project are involved too.



Tell us about your barriers to vaccination

We want to find out more about parent carers who want a **Covid-19** vaccination (for themselves or a family member), but haven't had one due to disability or SEND.
