Government publishes SEND improvement plan

This week, the government finally published its **SEND and Alternative Provision Improvement Plan**, in response to the Green Paper published in March 2022.

We haven't had time to get our heads around all the detail yet but here's a summary of the key announcements, and links to further information.

New practical advice resources online from Brighton & Hove and East Sussex

Sussex Community NHS Foundation Trust has produced a great new set of Occupational Therapy Sensory Videos for families with children and young people with sensory issues. There are explanatory videos such as 'What is sensory processing?' and 'Sensory modulation', as well as practical advice videos about 'Calming strategies', 'Alerting strategies' and issues like chewing, hair care, nail care, smells, etc.

East Sussex School Health and Children's Integrated Therapy and Equipment Service's new website is also packed with <u>useful advice</u> <u>about specific conditions</u> such as Down syndrome, autism, sensory processing difficulties or topics like eating and drinking, sleeping, mobility and more.

Here are some of the latest fab offers from the i-go leisure discount card for children and young people aged 0 to 25 with additional needs in East Sussex:

The <u>Chicken Circus</u> is flapping its way to Brighton's memorial Hall on May 20-21 - book your free spot at this Makaton friendly multi-sensory Fringe show now. The <u>Jungle Book Musical</u> is swinging into Hailsham this Easter half term, with £2.50 off ticket prices for i-go cardholders. <u>Active Youth SEND sessions</u> are starting up at Horntye Sports Complex, Hastings, for ages 6 to 18: sessions cost £1 with an i-go card. And Rye pool has had to close temporarily, but they've made i-go cardholders a new £5/hour <u>table tennis offer</u> at Rye Sports Centre.

Finally, not an i-go offer, but <u>sensory storytelling and crafts</u> for ages 2+ by Head2Head Sensory Theatre will be coming to Denton Island Community Centre on Sat 25 March – only £5 and carers go free.
