Updated 'behaviour' fact sheet

All children sometimes behave in ways that their parents can find a bit of a challenge. For some children with special educational needs or disability (SEND) this can be more serious because of the impact it has on them and the people around them. It's important to remember that challenging behaviour is a form of communication and trying good ways to respond to it about today, and tomorrow, and the next day.

We've updated our 'behaviour' fact sheet. Get tips on things that can help you, and things that can help your child, if they experience **distressed behaviour** or behaviours that challenge the people around them. Plus info on services that might be able to help, and links to further reading.

Get busy with your i-go Card this summer

There are loads of fab i-go **offers, events and SEND sessions** coming up this summer!

One carer goes free with an i-go card holder at the [Chequer Mead Theatre](#) in East Grinstead, so why not go to [Teddy Bear Storytime](#) on Thursday 22 June for a fun and friendly way to introduce your little ones to the theatre, whilst developing their language and social skills. Or for a magical **underwater musical adventure**, why not try [The Little Mermaid](#) on Thursday 24 August – including an exciting opportunity to meet the characters after the show!

[Encryption Escape Rooms](#) (near Lewes) are a wheelchair friendly venue who are happy to do what they can to make a visit enjoyable for all. There are three **themed escape rooms**, one indoor treasure hunt and an award-winning café, and i-go cardholders get 20% off.

Fancy getting out in the sun? [Globetrotters mini golf](#) are back at Tilgate Park all summer, until October 1st, with 25% off tickets to play, including family tickets. Finally, every Monday 10am to 11am during the school holidays, [Lewes Castle](#) is holding additional needs sessions.
