

# SEND reforms Change Programme rollout

Over the next two years, as part of the **South East Change Programme Partnership**, Brighton & Hove and East Sussex will be helping **test proposed reforms** from the government's SEND Improvement Plan, published in March 2023.

Read on to learn about the <u>plan to test the</u> <u>proposed reforms</u>, including how parent carers will be involved in the testing process.



### Face 2 Face groups and events

The Face 2 Face parent carer coffee mornings have restarted for 2024, with a choice of **12 groups across Brighton & Hove and East Sussex!** We trialled a meet-up for parent carers of 16 to 25 year olds in Eastbourne before Christmas, and will be holding one in Uckfield in the next month or two as well.

In addition to our in-person groups, we also have several **WhatsApp peer support groups**, and a private Facebook group. When you sign up to join our <u>Facebook group</u> you'll be asked a couple of questions to verify that you're part of the Face 2 Face project.

We also frequently hold **wellbeing events and activities** like relaxation workshops, gentle walks, singing for wellbeing, and more. You'll be able to book onto these events through <u>Eventbrite</u>, and we'll announce them on the <u>Amaze Facebook</u> page, so keep an eye out!



### **Volunteer with Face 2 Face**

### i-go offers this half term

Looking for something to do this half term? The i-go card has you covered:

For a **family friendly day out**, why not check out <u>Godstone Farm</u>, with animal interactions, reptile house, dinosaur discovery trail, huge adventure playground, and more! Carer goes free with i-go cardholder. Or explore the beautiful <u>Borde Hill gardens</u> in Haywards Heath, re-opening Feb 10 – £5 for i-go cardholders, carer goes free.

Don't mind going a little **farther afield**? Check out the half term <u>dark skies</u> <u>festival at Amberley Museum</u>, Arundel, with loads of family activities on offer – carers and under 5s go free. Or go wild at <u>Aldingbourne Country Centre</u> with their safari-themed bouncy castles, guinea pig snuggling, and more! Under 2s and carers go free.

How about some **games**? Head to <u>Dark Master Escape Rooms</u> in Crowborough and see if you can beat the clock, with 20% for i-go cardholders and everyone with them.
