Welcome to our July newsletter

Worried about SEND reforms?

Amaze CEO, Sally Polanski, shares Amaze's perspective "Media coverage on potential SEND reforms, and what impact they might have, has been ramping up in recent weeks. We know this uncertainty is really worrying and it adds to the pressure of raising a child or young person with additional needs.

"We expect more concrete news about the reforms to come in the autumn. Meanwhile, Amaze and the local parent carer forums, ESPCF and PaCC, are working behind the scenes to share and represent your experiences to policy makers. We have written to MPs, PaCC joined a meeting with Education Minister, Bridget Phillipson, this week and we are involved in campaigns led by the Disabled Children's Partnership and others to voice concerns that the SEND legal framework must not be diluted.

"Locally, we will need to work through any changes that emerge with our local authorities, health and other partners. We will keep you informed as soon as things become clear. Supporting each other through change will be more important than ever."
